

Quest, Textron to set up SEZ at Belgaum

TEXTRON Systems and **QuEST Global**, a provider of outsourced engineering services and manufacturing, announced that the two companies are working together on the development of the **QuEST Global Special Economic Zone (SEZ)** in **Belgaum**.

The SEZ, endorsed by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, covers 300 acres and is focused on Precision Engineering. As a sector-specific economic zone, this area will provide build-to-
